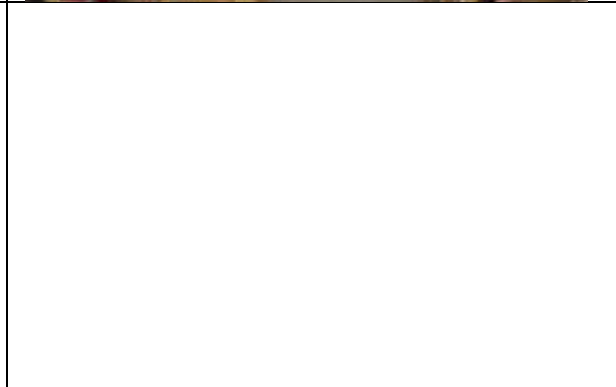

Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights and Innovations

14.03.2017

One day workshop on **Intellectual Property Rights and Innovations** was held at **Thiagarajar College** on **14.03.2017** at Diamond Jubilee Hall. The faculty members of the science departments (40 numbers) and 20 research scholars participated in the workshop. The workshop was inaugurated with prayer song. **Dr.Rm.Murugappan**, Dean, Curriculum development and head Dept.of Zoology and Microbiology delivered the welcome address. The presidential address was given by **Dr.M.Eyini**, **Principal**, Thiagarajar College. **Dr.P.Tharmaraj**, Associate Professor of chemistry and Research coordinator introduced the resource person **Dr.M.Kantha Babu**, Director, Center for IPR, Anna university, Chennai and also gave a brief introduction about the workshop to the participants.

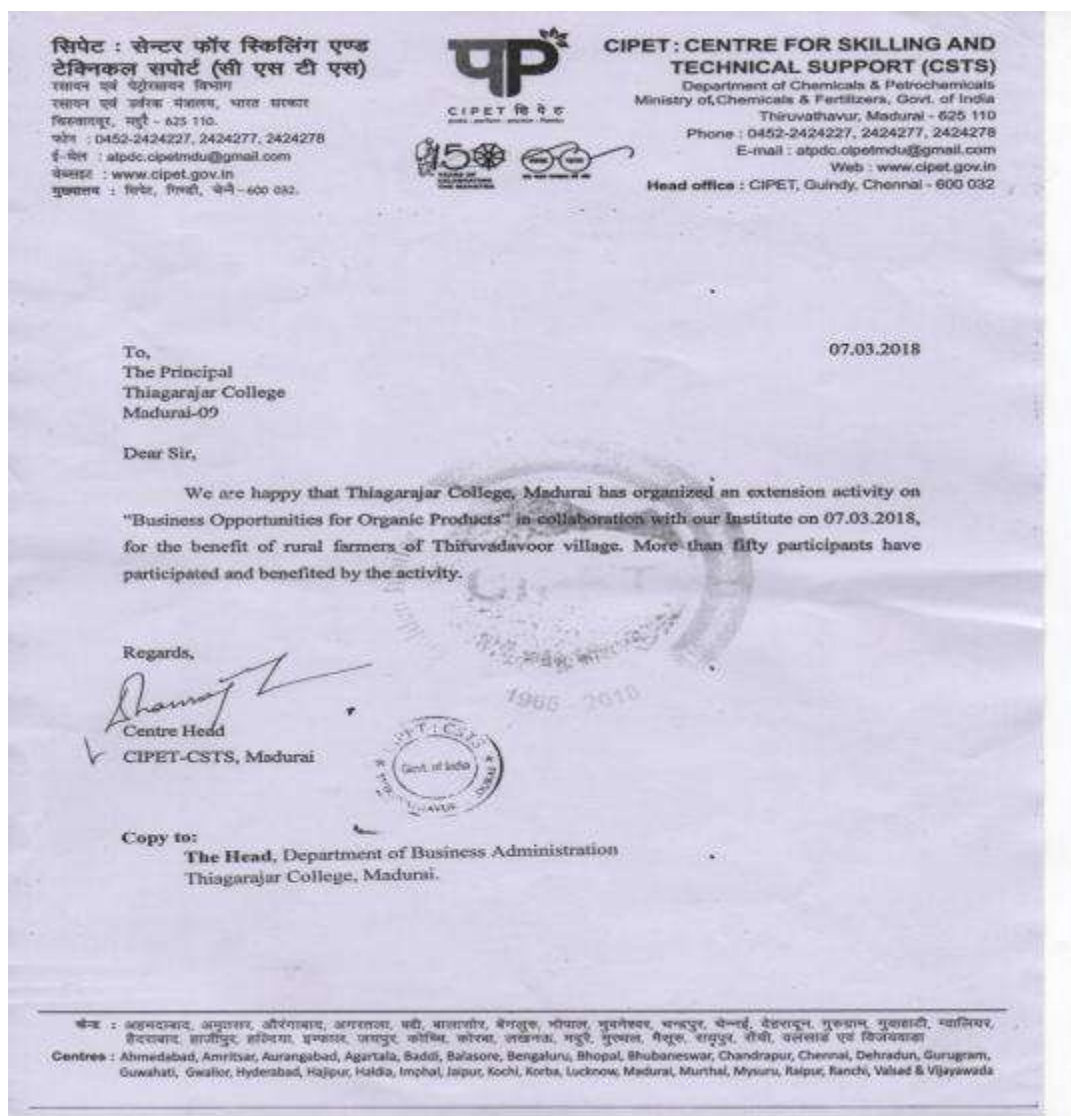

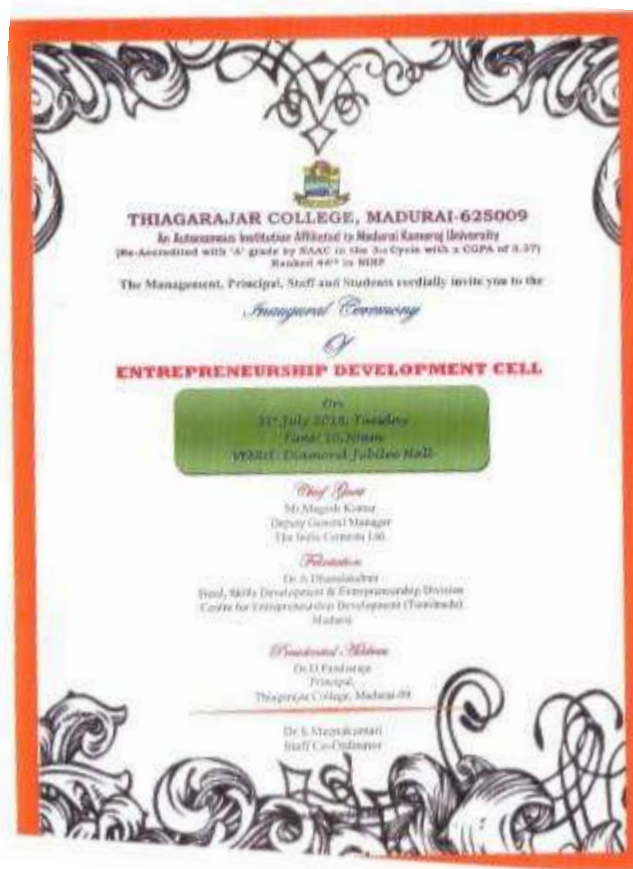


